- As of 2023 the region's population **increased by 0.1%** since 2018, growing by 21. Population is expected to **increase by 0.8%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 162.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 5.8% in Jackson County, IA from 7,539 to 7,099. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 9.4%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 71.1% to 67.2% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.1% of Jackson County, IA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.0% below the national average), and **10.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Warehousing and Storage.







Unemployment by Gender











Unemployment Rate Trends


Jackson County, IA had a January 2024 unemployment rate of 4.66%, increasing from 3.06% 5 years before.




Millennials

Jackson County, IA has 3,041 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,929.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Jackson County, IA. The national average for an area this size is 5,791 people 55 or older, while there are 7,348 here.




Racial Diversity

Jackson County, IA has 2.11 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 2.41 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Employment Concentration




Occupation Employment Concentration

Top Occupation Earnings




Top Posted Occupations
