Takeaways

- As of 2023, the region's population hasn't changed since 2018. Population is expected to decrease by 0.2% between 2023 and 2028, losing 36.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 5.2% in Jackson County, IA from 7,539 to 7,144. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 9.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 71.1% to 66.4% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.6% of Jackson County**, **IA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.5% below the national average), and **10.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Warehousing and Storage.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2023, the region's population hasn't changed since 2018. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.2%** between 2023 and 2028, losing 36.



Job Trends






Jackson County, IA had a March 2024 unemployment rate of 3.51%, increasing from 3.06% 5 years before.

Millennials




Veterans

Jackson County, IA has 1,236 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 988.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Jackson County, IA. The national average for an area this size is 5,791 people 55 or older, while there are 7,348 here.




Violent Crime

Jackson County, IA has 9.21 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 18.22 per 1,000 people.










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Employment Concentration




